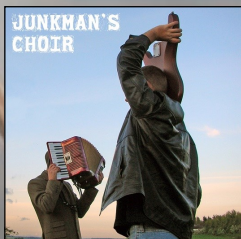
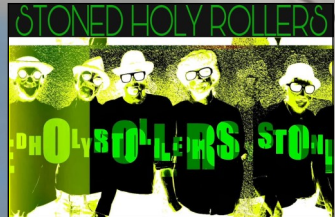

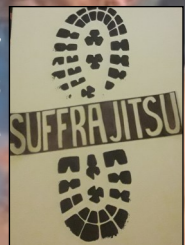
Stoned Holy Rollers

Twin Edinburgh with Gaza– Council Petition

Join the call on Edinburgh Council to give sister city status to Gaza city. The Council Petition should have been heard on 29th March but the Policy Committee were threatened by Israel that they could be jailed for so doing, as they would be “de facto” supporting Hamas. The Council withdrew the item from the agenda , indicating it must “take legal advice”.



The Mayor of Gaza, Dr Yahya Sarraj, provided evidence he was not appointed by Hamas. Also, Michael Mansfield QC, the renowned Jewish barrister, has advised the Council they have nothing to fear by twinning. It is hoped the Council will now discuss the matter. We have also set up the Edina-Gaza Twinning Association, which will facilitate twinning activities such as teaching English on Zoom and purchasing Gazan skills in web design and business accounting, both activities suitable for net-based trade- thus using the web to beat the Israeli blockade, now in its 15th year.

Moyle District Council in NI twinned with Gaza in 2012 and helped with tourism,

sport, football, health care, women’s issues, library management, parks improvement & maintenance, sewage processing and education. Due to reorganisation, Moyle Council no longer exists. But if this is what Moyle can do with a population of 17,000, what could Edinburgh offer, with a population of half a million? Dundee is twinned with Nablus and Glasgow with Bethlehem, now Edinburgh can show it cares.



Arthur Balfour in 1917 was key to creating modern Israel and hailed from East Lothian, so Edinburgh is an appropriate choice for beginning to address historical wrongs to the Palestinians. More at
