THE LIES THEY TELL

32 e-mails sent to City of Edinburgh Council in 2022 objecting to the proposal to twin with Gaza City with comment from Pete Gregson, Petitioner for Gaza twinning

These emails were obtained through an Subject Access Review request by Pete Gregson. There are two tranches- because the petition went before Policy Committee twice. Some emails are dated from March, when it was withdrawn following Israeli threats; the second hearing was in August, following legal assurances from Police Scotland that there was nothing illegal in twinning with Gaza..

Because the correspondent's names are redacted, it is impossible to know how many are from Edinburgh residents. It is likely many come from the Glasgow Friends of Israel, as there are few Jews in Edinburgh. Pete has reviewed the emails with comments in italics below.

The Committee refused to allow either Gazans, supporters or the petitioner to address the Committee because of "legal considerations". The Council has refused to disclose these, so the FOI is now under consideration by the Scottish Information Commissioner.

The author considers Gaza Municipality to be under the control of Hamas whereas all the evidence points to this not being so (<u>https://www.twingaza.com/gaza-council-explains-how-mayor-was-appointed-no-hamas-involvement/</u>).

S/he states that the Hamas charter declares "Fight the Jews and Kill them"- also untrue. Firstly, no-one declaring themselves Jewish outside of Palestine have been harmed by Hamas. Those who have colonised Palestine and kill Arabs to do so call themselves Jews, so anti-colonial struggle unsurprisingly leads to fighting and killing. If one consults the Hamas Policies of 2017 (https://www.jewishvirtuallibrary.org/hamas-2017-document-of-general-principles-and-policies) there is a clarification:

"Hamas does not wage a struggle against the Jews because they are Jewish but wages a struggle against the Zionists who occupy Palestine."

The usual claims that Hamas spends aid money on rockets and launches them from schools are made. Neither of these are proven: Wikipedia says a UN inquiry found the claims (by Israel) to be untrue. The author complains that media reporting in the UK is biased towards the Palestinians, but s/he does not pause to consider why this might be so (ie that Israel runs an apartheid state predicated on the theft of Palestinian land). In actual fact, UK media is so fearful of complaints from Israeli supporters in the UK, which are well co-ordinated by those calling themselves Jews who support Israel- by the Israeli Embassy—that they seldom cover attacks on Palestinians. I oppose this nonsensical twinning with any country who permit prescribed terrorist to groups within their borders while their residents are kept in abject poverty and allows them free rain to do as they wish, have you looked at womens rights within those very terrorist organisations you wish to promote the subjugation of women and young or same sex relationships or will those issues be conveniently swept under a rug

The author opposes twinning with Gaza because it "permits prescribed terrorist groups within its borders whilst their residents are kept in abject poverty".

The only truth here is that the residents are kept in abject poverty, but this is because of the illegal blockade by Israel, now in its 16th year- not because of Hamas. It is a form of collective punishment that the world has declared illegal.

Given the severity of the humanitarian crisis, Israel's duties to "protected persons" as an occupier of the Gaza Strip under Article 55 of the Fourth Geneva Convention require that it allows the passage of all aid, foodstuffs, and water. "Protected persons" are civilian individuals who find themselves, in case of an armed conflict or occupation, in the hands of a power of which they are not nationals. In this case, "protected persons" are the people of Gaza. By placing strict controls and limitations on all provisions for Gaza, including basic food, water, and medical aid, the Israelis have violated this stipulation of the Geneva Convention.

Israel's blockade also violates international law under Article 33 of the Fourth Geneva Convention whereby: "No protected person may be punished for an offence he or she has not personally committed. Collective penalties and likewise all measures of intimidation or of terrorism . . . against protected persons and their property are prohibited." This article prohibits the use of collective punishment of protected persons, the breach of which constitutes war crimes. By having breached this article, the Israelis are guilty of war crimes under the Geneva Convention.

The UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA) said in a report issued on 1st July 2022 that Israel's blockade on the Gaza Strip should be fully lifted in line with UN Security Council Resolution 1860.

The "terrorism" label given to Hamas is one that Israel has pushed some countries into adopting. In December 2018, the United Nations General Assembly rejected a U.S. resolution condemning Hamas as a terrorist organization.

Dear Mr.

I am sending this email to you as a concerned citizen of Edinburgh.

It is appalling that anyone should even consider the twinning of Gaza with Edinburgh. This petition should never even have reached such a stage. Gaza today is a theocratic, totalitarian mini state. The poor people of Gaza indeed deserve sympathy. They are being held hostage by an illegitimate Hamas regime, not interested in peace, but only in death to Jews and the destruction of the state of Israel, in the name of a particular interpretation of the Islamic religion.

The opportunity for peace and prosperity disappeared the minute that terrorists took control of Gaza. They have nothing to offer the suffering people except death and destruction. It is unthinkable to give moral or financial support to such a regime by twinning the two cities of Edinburgh and Gaza at the present time.

Of course, humanitarian assistance should be welcomed, so long as it is strictly controlled by the donors, since the present regime is good at diverting funds and materials. Huge investments, both private and from the E.U. and others, have already been destroyed since Hamas seized power. The opportunity to turn Gaza into the Singapore of the middle east existed but they chose a different path.

I am not sure if it is possible to untwin cities that twinned with Gaza in more hopeful times. It is likely however that many will put everything on hold till better times. Now is not the time to discuss such a proposal in the city of Edinburgh.

It's important to note that the Hamas regime is quite legitimate; it was elected democratically in 2006, after all. Their mandate was opposition to the Israeli takeover of Palestine and they believe Israel has no right to exist. Their position has nothing to do with "a particular interpretation of the Islamic religion"- it is founded on the Palestinian right to self-determination, by those who worship Allah– most Palestinians are Muslim, after all.

Their religious grounding is partly why they were elected by the Palestinian people, but their steadfast refusal to accept Israel is key; furthermore they were seen to be less corrupt than Fatah- who maintain control in the West Bank, as the "Palestinian Authority" (PA). Inter-Palestinian strife was created because Fatah refused to recognise Hamas' victory in the 2006 elections.

The claim that the "opportunity for peace and prosperity disappeared the minute that terrorists took control of Gaza" is laughable- given what has befallen those Palestinians who were under the control of Fatah in the West Bank and Jerusalem, under a PA which suppresses local dissent and is ineffective in preventing Palestinian land being taken, alongside regular raids by Israeli soldiers into the cities nominally controlled by the PA. In some instances, Israeli police work alongside PA Police in targeting unruly Palestinians. The PA has a draconian ban on criticism– human right campaigner Issa Amro was arrested for criticising the PA on Facebook.

After Hamas won the elections, the <u>Quartet</u>—comprising the United States, the European Union, Russia and the United Nations—demanded that the new Hamas government accept all previous agreements, recognize Israel's right to exist, and renounce violence; when Hamas refused, they <u>cut off aid to the Palestinian Authority</u>. The quartet refused to accept that Hamas had been elected <u>because</u> they consider Israel to be an illegal body.

Repeated attempts at reconciliation between Hamas and Fatah have failed, and the first Palestinian elections for 15 years, in which Hamas was due to compete, were called off by President Abbas (leader of Fatah) in April 2021.

The "death and destruction" described above that has been visited upon the Gazans comes not from Hamas but from the Israelis in their illegal collective punishment; in fact, Hamas are entitled to use military force (including rockets) to end the occupation— the 1982 UN ruling permits this.

Furthermore, Gaza is definitely not a theocratic totalitarian mini-state. No-one is forced to attend a mosque– and there are many Christians– at least 1,000, who attend their own churches, without interference from any authorities.

Astonishingly, the author thinks Israel is not responsible for the suffering of the Palestinians!

There is a huge amount here; most points are dealt with elsewhere.

The author states "Hamas gets money and instead of helping civilians they spend the money not on schools or hospitals but in building terror tunnels, firing rockets and stealing aid" - and continues at length about Hamas rockets. In the past 20 years Hamas rockets have killed 44 Israelis; Israel, on the other hand, has killed over 10,000 Gazans.

The author goes on "If the Palestinians put down all their weapons & stopped launching their missiles, there would be no more war... Is the Israelis put down all their weapons, there would be nor more Israel. Read that again. The Palestinians will not stop until every Jew is throwwn into the sea. If you don't believe me, look at their charter."

This writer has refused to look at the various communiques since the Hamas original one in 1987; they have moved on a long way since then and have indicated that Jews could continue to practise their faith in a new Palestine.

The author continues "The Hamas Charter calls for every Jew to be killed, anywhere in the world including me." (<u>www.thetimes.co.uk/article/kill-all-the-jews-says-senior-hamas-figure-zvx9jshbb</u>) In July 2019 a Hamas leader, Fathi Hamad, **did** encourage Palestinians across the globe to kill Jews, but Hamas immediately distanced itself from his words. "These comments do not represent the official positions of the movement and its consistent, adopted policies, which say our conflict is with the (Israeli) occupation which occupied our land and sullies our holy places and not a conflict with Jews across the world or Judaism as a religion," it said.

Hamas are at pains to limit their military actions against Zionists to Israel– they never followed the PLO models that involved plane hijackings or action in any other country outside Palestine.

The truth is that Hamas has only taken sporadic steps over the years to impose Sharia, or Islamic law, on already conservative Gaza, and even then has usually backed down in the face of criticism.

He says "Are you aware that Palestinians don't have free press in Gaza? They don't tell their perspective. They tell Hamas controlled stories and are executed for anything against them."

There is no evidence of anyone ever being executed in Gaza for criticising Hamas. People get executed for spying for Israel.

He continues "For 70 years Palestinian educational leaders have fed their children a steady diet of hate. Idolising suicide bombers and celebrating death, right in the classroom. They are taught at a young age to hate = child abuse."

He declares "Peace starts with acknowledging reality. It isn't Israelis holding Palestinian people back in Gaza, it is Hamas. I wish to see a two-state solution, with both Israel and Palestine living peacefully as neighbours but if we want innocent Palestinians to have any chance of overcoming poverty and oppression, we firstly need to free them of Hamas." The author does not recognise that a two-state solution is now impossible; the land left unoccupied by Israel could not be made into a state; Israelis have built many roads and walls cutting what was once the West Bank to pieces.

The writer notes that Canada, the European Union, Israel, Japan, Australia, the United Kingdom and the United States have designated Hamas as a terrorist organization.

For clarification: New Zealand and Paraguay have designated only its military wing as a terrorist organization. (Interestingly, all the above (bar Japan) are settler-colonial societies— and most were initiated by the UK, which also helped create Israel, by supporting the Zionist occupation from 1917 onwards)

Hamas is not considered a terrorist organization by Brazil, China, Egypt, Iran, Norway, Qatar, Russia, Syria and Turkey.

In December 2018, the United Nations General Assembly rejected a U.S. resolution condemning Hamas as a terrorist organization.

The author seems ignorant of the fact that Hamas won a big election victory in 20076and has been calling for fresh elections ever since, as they believe they would win- Abbas and Fattah refuse elections, always putting up one objection or another.

The writer continues by talking about the "weaponisation of Palestinian children". This was reported in an article about a children's summer school where the kids dress up in military uniforms and pose with toy guns. The article originally appeared in "Palestinian Media Watch", a pro-Zionist agency- authored by Lt. Col. (res.) Maurice Hirsch - presumably an officer from Israeli Army. It is not surprising that this activity takes place in a summer school; kids in the UK are encouraged to do the same in their school army cadets. In a country that has been effectively at war for over 70 years, it should not be unexpected that even children will want to resist an occupation that discriminates against them.

Later on, the writer complains of "the apparent UN/UNICEF mission to unjustifiably vilify Israel", ignoring the fact that Israel has refused to comply with any UN resolution placed upon it.

The email then states "This council is fanning the flames of antisemitism with this agenda which spills into the real world and has real consequences. I urge the council to oppose and take urgent steps to remove the dangerous twinning proposal from your agenda."

There is the usual ploy here: of declaring support for Gaza as being synonymous with antisemitism. Again, we see a simple refusal to consider historical reasons as to why Edinburgh should make amends for Balfour's stupid action. It was Balfour himself who was the antisemite here— he was keen to be rid of Britain's Jews and believed the solution lay in sending them to Palestine.

He was also an evangelical Christian who believed that a return to Palestine by the Jews would herald the second coming of Christ and their conversion to Christianity, or their burning in hell- as Israeli Historian <u>Ilan Pappé</u> has noted.

The meeting (with a gay man) was fixed for nightfall at one of Gaza City's beachfront restaurants.

The place is almost empty. Sami (not his real name) sits at a table, looking hesitant. He only starts speaking after the waiter has left us.

"I had to get married so as not to damage my family's reputation," the 40-year-old Gazan whispers.

To be gay in the "world's largest open-air prison" has been a constant struggle, he says. Whereas LGBTQ Palestinians living in Israel or the West Bank have the opportunity to leave their conservative towns and villages to find relatively safe spaces in Haifa, Tel Aviv-Jaffa or even Ramallah, Gazans are trapped in what he calls a "homophobic society."

At risk of harassment, torture or worse from Hamas or members of their own families, queer Gazans often hide away in fear. In the Strip, "passing" as straight can be a matter of survival. But this presents Sami with a big problem. "I want to be gay, I want to have a partner and be in love," he says, struggling to hold back tears.

He takes a deep breath and composes himself. "It's impossible in this community. I have met many homosexuals in Gaza online. But everyone is afraid of everyone. Some have been punished, some have been killed. Others killed themselves. One of my best friends was gay," he relates. "He took his own life. His father called me day and night for a week to ask me how his son could have done such a thing

- but I couldn't say anything. Even dead, I had to protect his honour.

Shortly before he committed suicide, we sat down together and he asked me, 'If I kill myself, will God forgive me for being gay?'"

The proposer has held a series of public meetings promoted as "An ideal opportunity to learn about the Palestine-Israeli situation and to improve discussion skills in a friendly and supportive environment"; however, the content sought to sow the seeds of hatred and intercommunal disharmony. Outbursts of hateful and discriminatory remarks towards Jews and the Jewish State were interspersed with clips from racist and anti-Jewish videos and websites. Edinburgh's Quaker Meeting House cancelled a booking for one of the lectures, explaining; while Quakers "Support hearing a range of voices on controversial issues.... The provocative imagery used by LAZIR is not in the spirit of the peaceful resolution of conflict".

Offensive and Unacceptable

Gregson has publicly expressed the following beliefs:

a) They're (Jews) not the same as Nazis because they don't use gas chambers. But they have got the same idea about racial purity and the racial purity that the Jews want is that you have to be Jewish, otherwise you're the enemy".

b) "Nobody stops this racist march because we feel guilty because of the Holocaust. This is the card that the Jews in Israel play".

c) "The Zionists have just as much pleasure killing Arabs".

Misrepresentation

Based on misrepresentation, falsehood and historical revisionism, the petition lacks honesty and credibility. It bears no semblance to the definition of twinning as expressed here;

"A twinning is the coming together of two communities seeking, in this way, to take action with a European perspective and with the aim of facing their problems and developing between themselves closer and closer ties of friendship".

The anti-Semitic comparisons between Nazi crimes and the Israeli-Palestinian conflict demonstrate LAZIR's ulterior motives. It would be shameful if the city council of Scotland's capital city, having adopted in full the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance (IHRA) Working Definition of Anti-Semitism, were to fail a test of sincerity.

Yours, etc

The last page propounds lies about me- I was expelled from my union for criticising Israel- I said it was a racist endeavour and that it exaggerated the Holocaust for political ends. These are both deemed antisemitic under the IHRA Definition of Antisemitism, which so many trade unions have adopted. This fraudulent and politicised definition was created to protect Israel and has been promoted by Jewish organisations who support Israel. It has led to the loss of our freedom of speech on Israel. The email makes comments about Hamas from unattributed sources- it is unclear which Palestinian factions are saying that it has imposed leaders on Gaza Strip municipalities.

The video showing the election of the mayor at an Itjima (meeting) of several hundred professionals, from every walk of life in Gaza, contradicts this claim. (see https://www.twingaza.com/gaza-council-explains-how-mayor-was-appointed-no-hamasinvolvement)

The usual slanderous claims against Hamas abound: the author claims it is "Responsible for suicide bombings against civilian

targets, the indiscriminate shelling of Israeli civilian populations" - but armed resistance is acceptable according to the UN.

The email also claims Hamas are" using Palestinian civilians as human shields". This is also untrue. Hamas fire their rockets from Gaza, one of the most densely populated area on Earth. The fighters are physically surrounded by civilians, who support the fight against Israel. The truth is that if rockets are to be launched from Gaza, civilians are present, but not as human shields. The Israelis, on the other hand, have been found guilty of using Palestinians as human shields in their attacks.

In any event, the twinning is not with Hamas, but with Gaza city.

In the paragraph headed "Anti-Semitic Lectures" the author is actually referring to our Palfilm nights where we showed videos about the fight of the Palestinians to survive (the videos screened can be seen at <u>https://www.onepalestine.land/videos-on-bogus-antisemitism-and-palestine/</u>).

The author states "the content sought to sow the seeds of hatred and intercommunal disharmony. Outbursts of hateful and discriminatory remarks towards Jews and the Jewish State were interspersed with clips from racist and anti-Jewish videos and websites."

This is a surprising assertion- there were never more than 8 people at these film nights and a Glaswegian Zionist only attended on one occasion. On that evening (as on all the evenings) there was none of the behaviour described. The Zionist was encouraged to share their videos and a respectful discussion ensued.

In the next paragraph "Offensive and Unacceptable" statements are attributed to me, none of which are true.

To conclude, I have never made comparisons between Nazi crimes of the gas chambers and the Israeli-Palestine situation, although the correspondent states that I have.

The email concludes by declaring that Edinburgh Council has adopted in full the IHRA Definition of Anti-Semitism and so it would be "shameful" if it twinned with Gaza.

Of course Edinburgh Council has done no such thing.
